

First Bale of Cotton.

The first bale of this season's crop of cotton was brought to town last Monday night and was grown by Mr. M. C. Yates on land which he is renting from the Texas Land & Loan company. The bale was ginned Wednesday afternoon by the Eagle Lake Gin company, weighed 535 pounds, classed strict middling and sold to W. F. B. Wicker at 13c. We learn that Mr. Yates has sold his entire crop of cotton to the Frank Stephens company for 10c a pound. The second bale of this year's crop, grown by Mr. W. E. Welford, is now at the gin and will be ginned today.

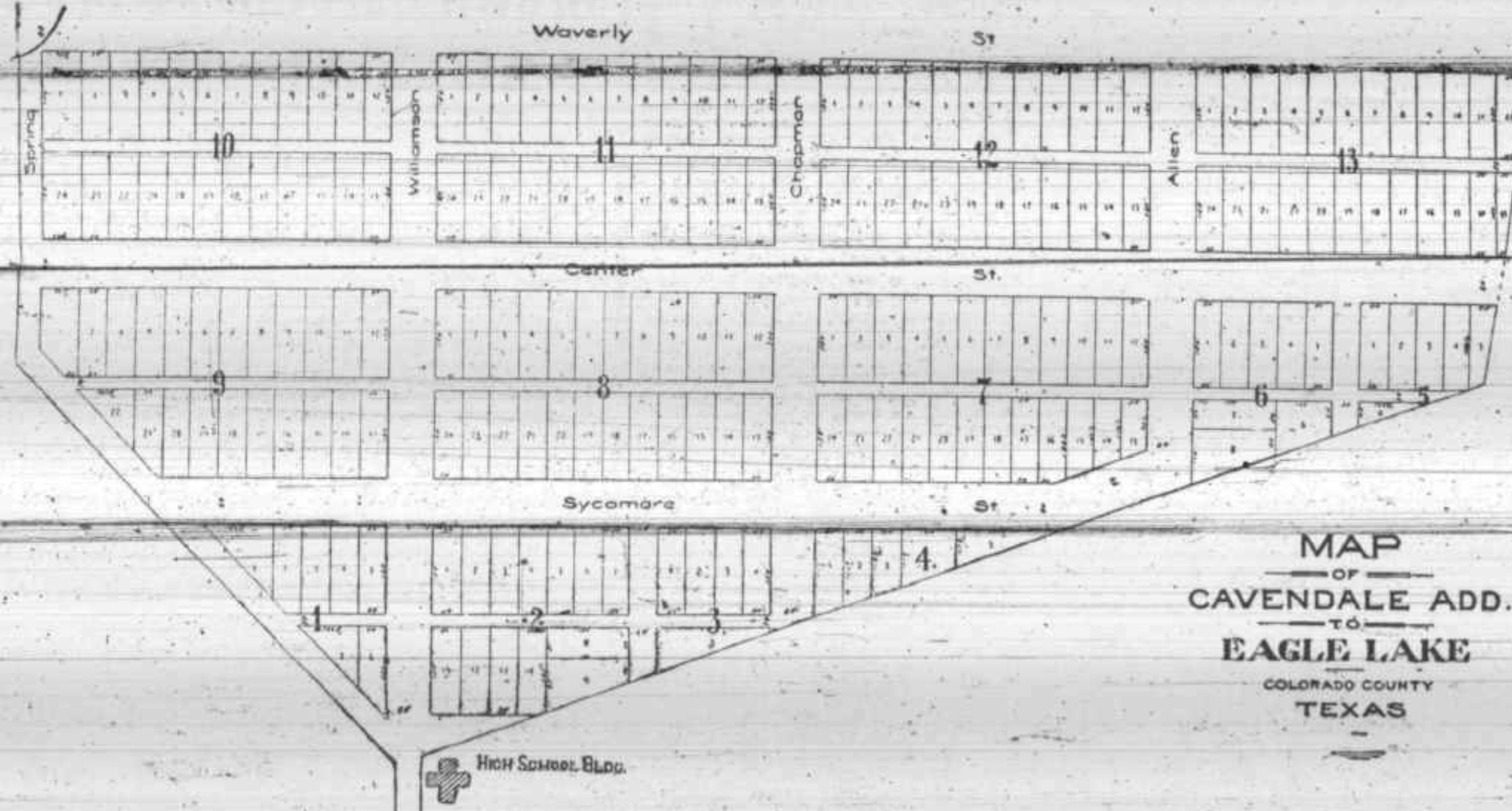
