Under such conditions the farmer can maintain the contest as long as he is willing to support his operatives in idleness - not longer. The difference between the spinner and the farmer is now around \$20 per bale, or \$240,000,000 on a 12,000,000-bale crop, not alone for this year, but for each succeeding crop. Two hundred and forty millions of dollars annually is a grand prize, the grandest ever contested for in the commercial world, and the world is watching the outcome with an interest with which it has watched no other. The farmer is in a position to win, and will win if he is willing to make a "last ditch fight" of it, and that ditch appears to be his objective point at this time. - Galveston News.
