SEVERAL PERSONS INJURED IN SOUTHERN PACIFIC WRECK.

Passenger Train Leaves Rails Near Lissie Monday Afternoon—Four Coaches Go Down Embankment—Eagle Lake Doctors Were Called.

Passenger train No. 10 on the Southern Pacific, running about ten miles late on account of a wreck further west, was wrecked about eight miles east of here and two miles east of Lissie about 2 o'clock Monday afternoon.

The injured were: W. S. Martin, Los Cruces, N. M., leg broken. S. R. Hall, Webster, Ky., leg broken.

John Stephens, negro cook, both legs badly scalded. Mrs. C. A. Gill, El Paso, cut about head, arms and hands.

Mrs. Gill's little baby, fingers hurt and bruised. Mrs. Dorothy Dierlof, Philadelphia, right arm bruised.

S. J. Kaufman, Philadelphia, side hurt. William Duguid, Westerly, R. I., back sprained.

E. L. Brown, West Middlesex, Pa., side sprained. R. D. Sadler, Washington, D. C., side hurt.

Jess Fox, Los Angeles, hands hurt. Forrest Fox, Los Angeles, head bruised.

Gustave Nallin, Milwaukee, left arm sprained. J. W. Hathaway, Chicago, bruised over body.

W. J. Stewart, Los Angeles, sprained ankle. Mrs. H. G. Lipp, Los Angeles, hurt on neck and head.

G. W. Redman, Spokane, left leg sprained. Chin Lee, New Orleans, left leg and jaw hurt.

Chen You, New Orleans, both arms and head skinned and bruised. J. D. Thomas, Knoxville, Tenn., bruises.

J. H. Gillespie, Walland, Tenn., right side hurt. William Mooney, chef on dining car, hip hurt.

Harvey Teneffe, cook on diner, hip and arm bruised. R. L. Lambson, dining car employee, hip and back hurt.

J. Spaight, dining car employee, leg skinned. A number of other passengers received minor bruises and cuts.

The engine, first to leave the wreck, is believed to have cut the bolts on the rails, and when the coaches struck the rails in this condition spread them causing the cars to go into the ditch. The engine tender and baggage car, while on the rails, did not leave the rails.

Four Pullman cars though both of them were also on the rails. Four coaches rolled over, and smashed up to any extent. While neither the engineer nor the conductor would give the HEADLIGHT any information concerning the wreck, the conductor even refusing to give the reporter a copy of the list of the injured which he already had in his possession, it is said that Engineer Smith stated that the engine was the first to jump the track. The engine is believed to have left the track on the public road crossing about two hundred yards behind where the wreck occurred. It is said that the train had gone several rail lengths on the ties before the engineer discovered it was off. He applied the air brakes and had the speed to only about ten or twelve miles an hour when the cars went over. Had it not been for this, coupled with the fact that the wrecked cars were the steel coaches, it is believed fatalities would have ensued.

The train did not stop at Lissie and was running at a high rate of speed when the engine jumped the track. Engineer Smith, Fireman A. M. Grillet and Conductor J. O. Hodges were in charge of the train. Doctors Fitzgerald, Cross and Bruce of this city made a hurried trip to the scene of the wreck in automobiles and administered medical aid to the injured. A relief train came out to the wreck and conveyed the injured to Houston. After arriving at Houston only two, the negro cook and W. S. Martin, were taken to the hospital. The injured were nearly all through passengers and continued on their journey.

TWO NEGRO WOMEN SLASHED IN SATURDAY NIGHT AFFRAY.

Zella Cook Charged With Cutting Annie ("Bill") Watson and Rachael Thomas—"Bill" Participated in Cutting Social Last Fall.

A cutting affray took place near the Aransas Pass railroad track near the colored portion of town about eleven o'clock last Saturday night wherein Annie Watson and Rachael Thomas were severely cut. Zella Cook, another negro woman, was arrested charged with having manipulated the knife that did the cutting. She was placed under a \$500 bond. The Watson woman who is known as "Bill," was set in the neck across the upper arm, the vein being easily seen through the wound, stabbed between the shoulders to the lungs and out on both shoulders. Rachael Thomas was cut in the breast and in the back. It was thought for a time that the Watson woman would die from her injuries. Zella Cook was also cut on the leg which was thought to have been done by herself accidentally in the mix-up. "Bill" figured prominently in a "raucous party" here last fall, having cut a negro woman named Mary Hill, in which fracas she was also slashed several times.
