A CASE OF MENINGITIS

Negro Girl on Duncan Farm Has Well Developed Case.

Dr. H. Fitzgerald was called to the I. V. Duncan farm, about two and a half or three miles from Eagle Lake Monday to see a patient, Victoria Dawson, a colored girl about sixteen years of age, daughter of Joe Dawson. The girl was taken sick on Sunday and when the doctor was called on Monday he found her stricken with a well developed case of spinal meningitis. Dr. Fitzgerald has been administering the antineuritis serum treatment to the patient. This treatment requires four injections of the serum, and up to this morning the doctor had already given two of the injections, and this morning the patient was doing well. Two more injections of the serum are yet to be given and it is believed the girl will recover from the disease. There seems to be no uneasiness felt for the spread of the disease.

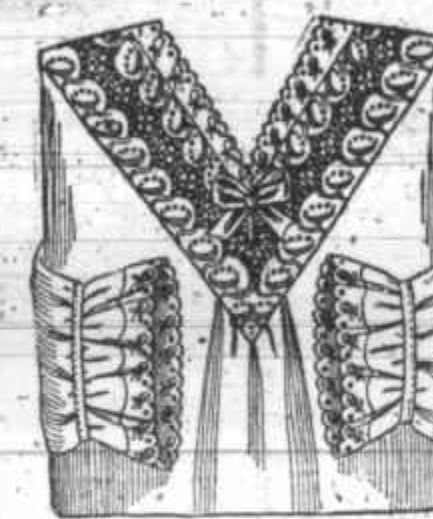

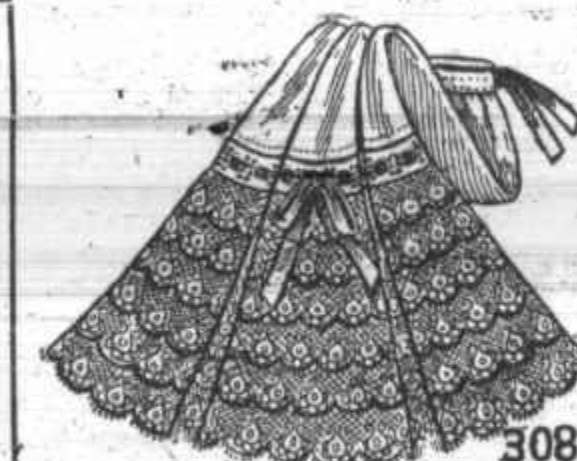
