Creamery to Start Soon.

The foundation for the building of the Eagle Lake Creamery Company has been finished and Contractor Keith is now preparing to put a large force of men at work to complete the building, which will probably be finished by the fifteenth of the present month. The creamery company expects to be ready for operations by the twentieth at the latest, as most of the machinery is now on hand and ready to be installed as soon as the building is completed. The creamery has provided cans of various sizes which are of the best quality and suitable for hauling or shipping cream. These cans will be furnished to patrons at cost. The creamery people are anxious to get in touch with prospective patrons and would like to have anyone interested in furnishing cream or milk call on them for make arrangements with the express company for the shipping of full and empty cans required for handling the product and provide separators for any one wishing them, and do anything else that they can in helping the patrons in taking the product to the plant. Their aim is to build up the business for the mutual interest of the creamery patrons, and the officers of the creamery are anxious at all times to receive any suggestions and to talk over matters with the patrons or those who wish to supply milk or cream. As soon as they are able to start, which will be about the twentieth, they will be ready to take milk and cream provided it is of good quality and in good condition. Those having no separator may bring in their milk and have it separated at the plant. In order to find out how much product is likely to be furnished in the beginning, the creamery officers would like for all parties who are interested to call or write and they will make an effort to get in personal touch with those desiring to furnish milk. Ice cream will be manufactured as soon as the plant starts up and arrangements will be made with some of the local fountains to serve same.
