

Starve the Fly.

Notwithstanding flies are not so bad at this season as during warmer weather, now is the time to do effective work to exterminate the pests. By keeping the premises clean during the winter there will not be so many flies hatched in the spring. The old adage: "An ounce of prevention is better than a pound of cure" applies with great force to the extermination of the fly.

At the recent meeting in Baltimore of the National Fly Association, the chairman of the convention, Edward H. Hodge, Jr., declared that the slogan, "Starve the Fly," should be changed to "Starve the Fly"; and this slogan deserves more consideration than the average person is likely to give it. By keeping premises, streets and alleys free from such things as constitute the food of

flies, they will be starved out and there will not be so many flies to swat when the weather grows warm again.

Trash is allowed to accumulate in places during the winter months which are kept clean in hot weather, because the danger from flies is the more greatly appreciated when they are swarming on every hand, and as a result breeding places of this character produce millions of flies which should never exist. In Texas, particularly in South Texas, flies are a pest during the winter, and if they are supplied with breeding places and food they will produce their kind regularly and when spring comes the work of swatting will be much more difficult than if precautionary measures were taken in time. —San Antonio Express.
