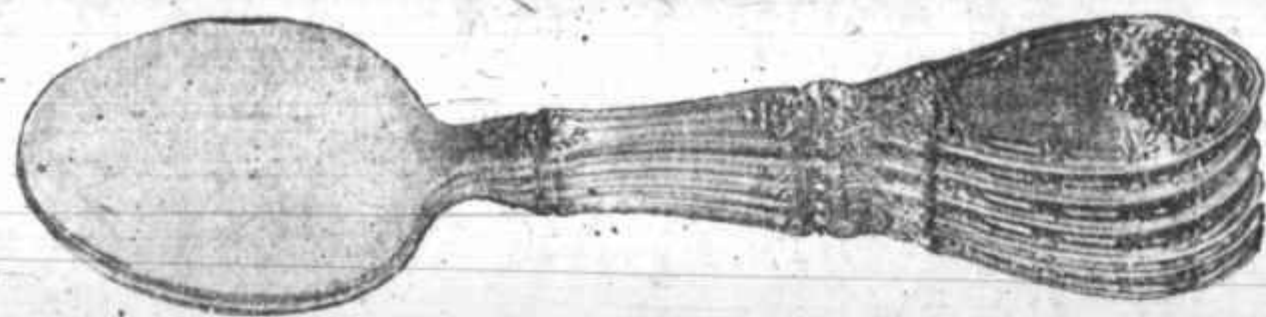

How much does the mail order house or the city merchant contribute to these necessary expenses? Not a penny, and they never will. Then give your patronage—all of it—to the home merchant who is justly entitled to it and will appreciate it.
