Keep livestock that will make use of all fodder, feeds, grains and waste products of the farm. The most successful general farmers market their crops "on the hoof." Sell all your scrub stock and keep only selected breeds. This applies just as much to work animals as to beef and dairy cattle, hogs and poultry. Circular No. 80, "Raising Hogs in the South," should be read and its plans followed by every farmer in Colorado county. It can be had by writing to Division of Publications, Dept. of Agriculture, Washington, D. C. The hog is a mortgage lifter if raised right, but if fed chiefly on corn it will keep its owner poor. Scrub cattle are profit stealers. It is more economical to have than two poor ones. I know of farmers with two or more light-weight fired teams who make less at farming than others with half the land and half the number.

of work stock. "Don't let superstition or 'the way-father-used-to-do' stand as obstacles to your success. Many have asked me about the influence of the moon on various farm operations. Let me quote Prof. Massey, one of the leading authorities on agriculture in the South: 'Answering an inquiry as to proper time of moon to haul manure and kill hogs, he replied in the Progressive Farmer: "The proper time of the moon for hauling out manure is when you have a load. Haul out the manure as fast as made and put it on the ground you intend to plant to corn in the spring, and the moon will not care a fig about it. The best time of the moon to kill hogs is when the hogs are fat, the weather cool and your knife sharp, and the moon will never know you have done it. Take care of your soil, farm well and let the moon shine when it is regulated to shine. You are not farming the moon but the earth." Keep accounts of all farm operations. It is the only sure way of knowing where your profits and losses come from. Have a diary and account book and write down each day the work done, the labor and team expense in each field. Keep separate accounts of demonstration plots; also an account for each live stock line. Enter all expenditures and receipts. Your books will give you interesting and valuable information as each account is closed. It will be a guide for next year. Time spent in planning farm operations and keeping farm accounts will save many losses and point you to where the profits are to be had. Let us form a County soil, crop and stock improvement club with membership open to all, the only requirements to be earnestness and real endeavor to live up to the ten commandments of the Farmers' Cooperative Demonstration Work. 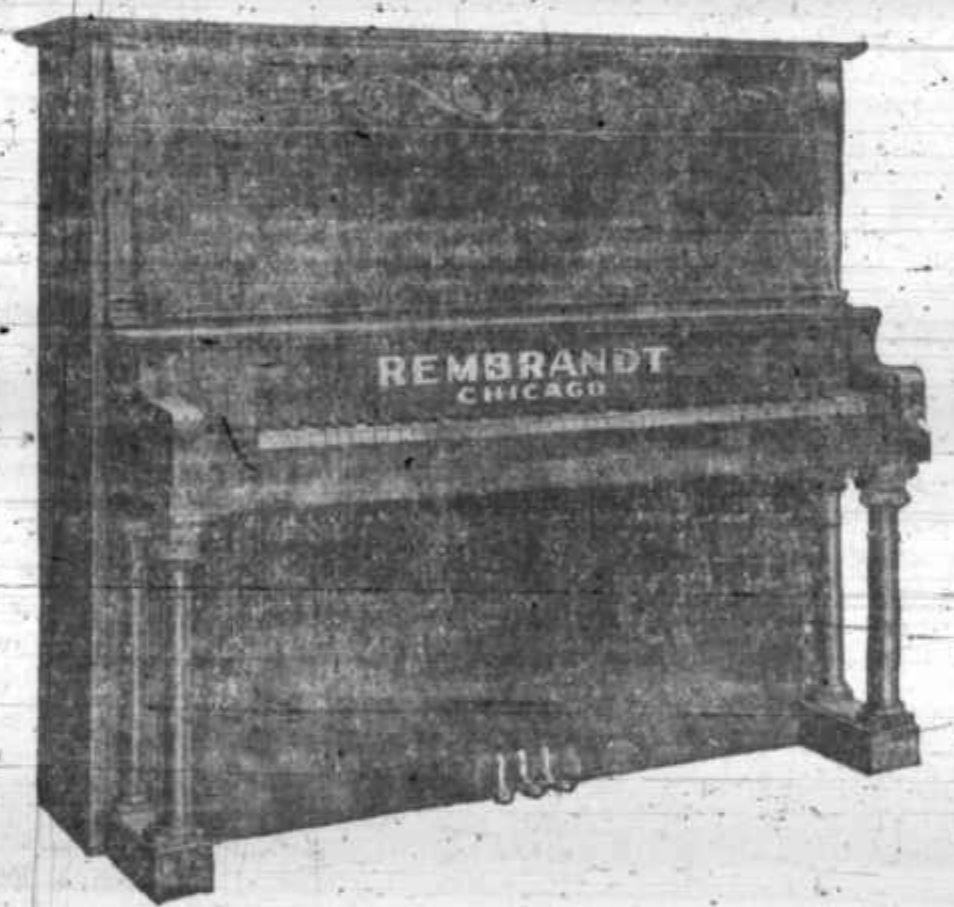
