Some Suggestions
Editor Headlight:
Because I am interested in Eagle Lake, and in fact interested in improvements everywhere, I ask a little space to make a few suggestions. I note more improvements about the live little city in the past two years than in the four previous ones, and not the least of these improvements are the setting out of trees and

building of sidewalks. A. E. Anderson in your last issue urged the people to plant trees and told what kind were best. Money judiciously spent in trees will pay better dividends than if invested in most anything else. Trees are the grandest small things in nature. The person who does not love trees is to be pitied. Probably nine-tenths of the shade trees set out perish for lack of proper care. Unless the season is unusually favorable, few trees will live unless the ground about them is kept reasonably loose for at least the first two years after planting. Mulching is first rate, and if a dry spell sets in water should be applied, but not to the surface without mulch.

Trees along the streets should not be allowed to branch, under twelve feet from the ground, so as not to interfere with the circulation of air and light. Well kept trees add beauty to the beauty of a town, and these, with well kept lawns, help to make homes attractive.

Let me also make a suggestion about another thing: Painting all wooden structures pays three times. First, in preserving the wood; second, the increased attractiveness enhances the value, and third, in the satisfaction the owner feels in having discharged one duty towards his property and the public. Every owner of property is under obligations to make it as pleasing as possible. "Beauty is power," and "a thing

of beauty is a joy forever." Ten thousand dollars spent in Eagle Lake in painting buildings and caring for trees and lawns would make the property in the city worth at least one hundred thousand dollars more.

I want to commend the HEADLIGHT for its earnest advocacy of a stock law, and for urging the citizens to set out trees along the streets. The stock law being in force, I hope it will advocate the tearing down of the wooden fences. These mar the beauty of the town. Eagle Lake can, and I believe will, in a few years become one of the very handsome cities of this favored Southland.
