Woman Breaks Ranks of A. & M. Faculty.

Under a double column picture
of Miss Bettie Mae Rogers, for-
mer teacher of the domestic science
department of the Eagle Lake
school, the Fort Worth Star-
under a communication from Col-
lege Station, prints the following:
It's all right for women to vote,
if they can—and if they want to.
It's all right for women to emu-
late men in any of the chosen
fields, if they can—and if they
want to. But what is becoming
of the woman whose chief desire
is to become maker and a home
builder? That's the question
that about three years ago began
to buzz in the brain of Miss Betty
M. Rogers, graduate of two of
the leading educational institu-
tions of Texas, and who has
specialized in domestic science.
Miss Rogers has broken the
solid phalanx of male instructors
at the Agricultural & Mechanical
College at College Station, Tex.,
and is the only woman in the
faculty.

associated with the extension de-
partment of the big Texas school.
Within another week she will be-
gin the work of organizing the
farm girls of Texas into clubs
for the purpose of studying can-
ning methods and poultry rais-
ing. "We need women in Texas
that know how to market, how to
buy groceries and how to scrimp,
and save in the kitchen and
throughout the household. When
our women are educated to a
greater degree of efficiency along
those lines you'll see the high
cost of living go down consider-
ably," says Miss Rogers.

Farm girls have the opportu-
nity of their lives and don't know
it. Why last year many Texas
girls cultivated one-tenth of an
acre of tomatoes and produced
more than \$50 worth of tomatoes
per tenth acre. That's what we
propose to teach in these clubs.
Any girl who will agree to cul-
ivate one-tenth of an acre of to-
matoes or other truck crop, un-
der instructions from the A. & M.
College and then can the vegeta-
bles after she has grown them
is eligible for membership in
our clubs. We want to encour-
age the idea that the farmer can
raise enough fruit, if it is prop-
erly canned, to furnish provender
for him the year around. We
want to give the country girl an
interest in the home.

Much of Miss Rogers' time will
be spent in travelling over the
state and making talks before
these girls. A graduate of the
College of Industrial Arts, for
the past two years Miss Rogers
has been instructor in domestic
science at the Eagle Lake High
School. She is a native Texan
and was graduated from the
High School at Seguin.

Miss Rogers is not a suffragette
and has no desire to vote. Her
chief hobby is to teach the young
idea how to can—and she thinks
she can.
