A DEPLORABLE TRAGEDY

Negro Boy Shot and Killed by Playmate Yesterday.

Yesterday evening at half past four o'clock, while some little negro boys were playing at the home of Della Norman, across the Sap railroad just back of the Davis homestead, "Sunny Boy," the ten year old son of Della Norman was shot just under the left eye with a Smith & Wesson .38 calibre pistol and instantly killed. Edward Shropshire, thirteen years old, son of Dolly Shropshire, was playing with a pistol, which he says he thought was unloaded, having pointed the pistol at the Norman boy and snapped it, the ball striking the boy just under the left eye. Death resulted in a very few minutes. The little boy that died was shooting at the moon just as the sun was setting, and he thought he had taken all the loads out, having emptied the cartridges out of the gun before he pointed it at the boy. Before the pistol fired, the Shropshire boy had pointed it at another little boy and snapped it, the boy running away from him. He next pointed it at the little Norman boy with the above result.

The tragedy is a deplorable one, and should be a lesson to all boys, regardless of color, to never play with pistols or guns of any kind.

The mother of the dead boy was on the street near the Eagle Lake Drug Company when she was told that her boy had been shot. Her shrieks and screams could be heard for blocks. She was told that her boy had been shot by a messenger who had run to town for a doctor. Dr. Cross with the Headlight reporter left at once in the doctor's automobile for the scene, but the boy was dead when the doctor reached him.
