Census Bulletin Shows Colorado County Cotton Production

The total number of bales of cotton ginned in Colorado County from the crops of 1912 is 2,338 according to a report which has just been issued by the Federal Census Department. This total excludes linters and the department counts round bales as half bales. The total production of Colorado County in 1911 was 18,896 bales and 16,012 bales in 1910. The total production of Texas in 1912 was 4,645,172 bales which is the largest in history. The crops of 1911 and 1910 were 4,197,152 and 2,940,988 bales respectively.

No value have been announced on the Texas cotton crop, but the large yield in the State was, in a measure, offset by the partial failure in other portions of the South which had a tendency to keep up prices. Commercial Secretaries.
