How to Keep Good Roads.

We should have men living along our roads, whose duty it should be to drag the roads as often as they need it, to fill up smooth over depressions before they wear into holes and ruts, and to look after and keep up the road generally. Divide the roads into sections of stated lengths and let out the upkeep of each section by contract. Have a road inspector for each county, whose duty shall be to give his whole time to the inspection of the roads of the county and to report and non-performance of duty that may occur. Require that the inspector be thoroughly qualified to fill his position. Require both contractors and inspectors to give bond for the faithful performance of their duty.

"What is over his duty?" and true saying. Make the upkeep of our roads "somebody's business" and we will have good roads at less than what bad roads now cost us. We won't have them until we do.—Frank L. Butts, in the Progressive Farmer.
