

SCHOOL COMMENCEMENT

Exercises Were Held in School Auditorium Monday Night.

The commencement exercises held in the school auditorium on Monday night, when three of our most popular girls and two of our most worthy young men were awarded their diplomas, were in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

After the invocation by Rev. Mr. Lovett and a musical selection by a string quartet, composed of Mr. and Mrs. Wiggins and Messrs. Kolberg and Anderson, Mayor Putney introduced the speaker of the evening, Dr. C. C. Taylor, professor of public speaking from the University of Texas.

Dr. Taylor took as his subject, "Service the Crown of Sovereignty." Ray Munn Fitzgerald and R. E. Williamson to the school board as those who, by earnest and efficient service and by strength of character, had shown themselves to be worthy of their confidence and the highest honors they had to bestow.

Following another beautiful selection by the quartet, Miss Madeline McKee, the valedictorian, read the class essay, "Attempt Not or Accomplish Well" in her natural and most charming manner.

Mr. F. S. Ulery, in behalf of the school, expressed the pleasure and satisfaction that they felt over the marked success of the graduates in the building of their characters as well as in their school records, after which he presented the diplomas and Mr. Morgan presented the honor certificates to those of all the grades who ranked first or second.
