Our Voters More Intelligent.

During the past decade we
have shown a decrease of 41 per
cent in illiteracy among the vot-
ers of this State. We have had
much agitation and considerable
legislation seeking to withdraw
the ballot from the illiterate and
the younger generation is ap-
parently better educated and
both causes may have contrib-
uted towards our registering a bet-
ter average.

We have 825 illiterate voters in
Colorado county according to a
recent census bulletin and 14.3
percent of our males of voting
age are unable to write. The
percentage in 1900 was 27.8. The
percentage of illiterates among
the native white voters of this
County is 2.4 foreign born, white
10 and negro 39.9 per cent.

Out of 1,000,000 males of voting
age in Texas 169,825 or 11 per
cent are illiterate. In 1900 we
had in the entire State 737,768
voters and 151 per cent were

New Divorce Law Pretty Rigorous.

Heretofore Texas has been
granting divorces on most any
ground. The divorce laws have
not been made in years. Under
the recent session of the Legisla-
ture tackled the subject. Here-
after divorces will not be so easily
obtained, nor will the path of the
divorces be so smooth as hereto-
fore.

Following is a part of the new
law that goes into effect July 1:
Article 4981. No suit for di-
vorce from the bonds of matri-
mony shall be maintained in the
courts of this State unless the
petitioner for such divorce shall
at the time of exhibiting his or
her petition, be an actual bona
fide inhabitant of the State of
Texas, for a period of twelve
months and shall have resided in
the county where the suit is filed
for six months next preceding
the filing of the suit; provided
that such suit shall not be heard
or divorce granted before the ex-
piration of thirty days after the
same is filed; and provided fur-
ther, that neither party to a divorce
suit, wherein a divorce is grant-
ed upon the ground of cruel treat-
ment shall marry any other per-
son for a period of twelve months
next after such divorce is grant-
ed.
