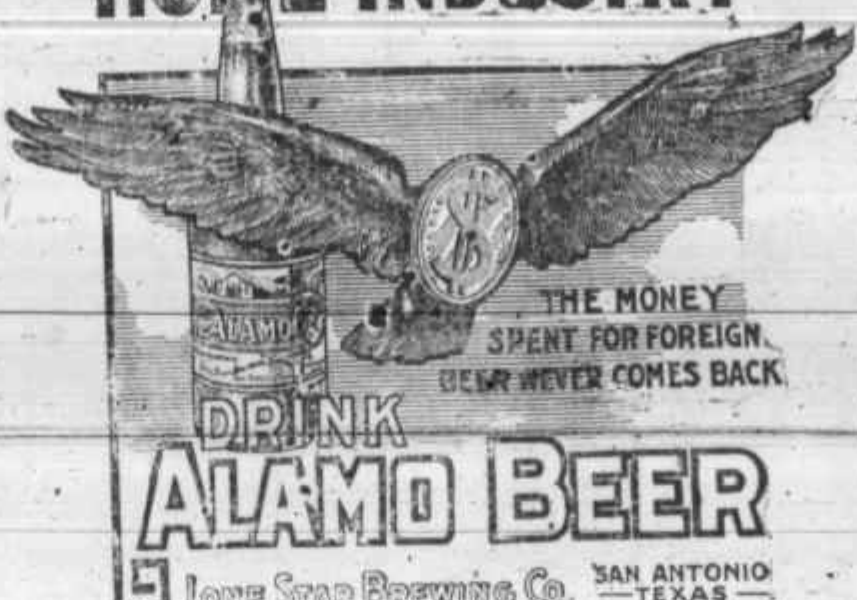

Mimic Battle in Shenandoah
The Shenandoah Valley where "Phil" Sheridan made his famous ride fifty years ago, is to hear again the song of the bugle, the galloping of horses and the crack of carbines and the boom of cannon, for the War Department is trying out the cavalry and has chosen the Shenandoah as the bloodless battleground. For two months this summer a full brigade of cavalry and a battery of horse artillery will maneuver and "fight" over the red roads, the green hills and fields near Winchester that figured in the great cavalry battles in the war between the States.

The department has leased a tract of ground, a mile broad and two miles long in the heart of the Shenandoah, seventy-five miles from Washington and orders to the troops call for two brigades of cavalry from Fort Riley, Allen, Vt., and Fort Oglethorpe, Ga., and the Cavalry Corps under a dusty summer sun before they reached the valley, and they must report July 20.

Great interest attaches to the maneuver. Secretary Garrison will be a frequent spectator, Major-General Leonard Wood, chief of staff, U. S. A., probably will spend much time there, and President Wilson may summon a White House automobile some Saturday and make a trip to the valley battleground.
