New Industry for Eagle Lake

Another industry is added to Eagle Lake in the Eagle Lake Fruit and Canning Company, composed of Messrs. Kolberg and Anderson and the fig growers associated with these gentlemen.

The erection of the plant is well under way and will be ready for the canning season early in August. The building is of corrugated iron of commodious size and planned for convenience in handling the fruit and products canned. It is located in the manufacturing section, on the Hahn property adjoining the Eagle Lake Manufacturing Company's plant on the south, with frontage on the railroad switch tracks.

Steam and water from Koennecke's ice plant will be utilized in the preparation of the canned products.

The canning plant this year will put up only figs, but it is proposed to so enlarge the plant in the future as to take in other fruits and vegetables also. There is no question but that this section can produce as fine fruits and vegetables as can be grown anywhere in Texas, and with the establishing of a local canning factory it will open up a profitable industry, which will be of immense value to the town of Eagle Lake and the tributary country.

The Eagle Lake section has repeatedly demonstrated that it can produce vegetables of fine quality, but local markets cannot always handle this produce except in limited quantities, consequently there has been but

little manifested in truck growing. But with the canning factory as an established industry the fruit and truck grower will be able to readily dispose of his products when an overstocked market would otherwise cause him a loss.

The fig industry is now well established in this section and has already proved to be a safe and profitable fruit crop, especially on our prairie lands. The fig crop this year promises to be heavy notwithstanding the dry weather experienced this summer. Messrs. Kolberg and Anderson have already contracted for the sale of the entire output of the plant this season, and the goods will be shipped to northern markets.

The interest in commercial fig orchards is greater than ever, and the orchard acreage is constantly growing. More than a hundred acres will be added to the fig orchard plantings in the Eagle Lake section during the coming fall and winter, and preparations for planting have already begun.

Figs are a sure fruit crop under the most adverse conditions and a crop failure is never known. The Eagle Lake soils and climate seem to be splendidly adapted to the growing of figs and those who make commercial plantings of figs are making no mistake.

Election Order

Be it ordered by the board of trustees of the Eagle Lake Independent School District that an election be held at the Band Stand in the Public Park in the town of Eagle Lake in the said Eagle Lake Independent School District on the 27th day of August, 1913, to determine whether the board of trustees of said district shall have power to annually levy and collect a tax upon all taxable property in said district, for the support and maintenance of public free schools in said Eagle Lake Independent School District, of and at the rate of not exceeding fifty cents on the \$100 valuation of taxable property in the district; such tax if voted, to be levied and collected for the year 1913 and annually thereafter unless it be discontinued as provided by law.

J. R. Westmoreland is hereby appointed manager of said election, and he shall select two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding same.

None but property tax payers who are qualified voters in said Eagle Lake Independent School District, shall vote at said election.

A copy of this order signed by the president and attested by the secretary of this board, shall serve as proper notice of said election, and the president shall cause notice of said election to be given in accordance with law.
