Election Order

Be it ordered by the board of trustees of the Eagle Lake Independent School District that an election be held at the Band Stand in the Public Park in the town of Eagle Lake in the said Eagle Lake Independent School District on the 27th day of August, 1913, to determine whether the board of trustees of said district shall have power to annually levy and collect a tax upon all taxable property in said district, for the support and maintenance of public free schools in said Eagle Lake Independent School District, of and at the rate of not exceeding fifty cents on the \$100 valuation of taxable property in the district, such tax to be levied and collected for the year 1913 and annually thereafter, unless it be discontinued as provided by law.

J. R. Westmoreland is hereby appointed manager of said election, and he shall select two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding same.

None but property tax payers who are qualified voters in said Eagle Lake Independent School District, shall vote at said election.

A copy of this order signed by the president and attested by the secretary of this board shall serve as proper notice of said election, and the president shall cause notice of said election to be given in accordance with law.
