COLUMBUS EAST BRIDGE WENT OUT LAST NIGHT

Temporary Repairs on East Columbus Bridge Washed Out Again Last Night.

The east bridge at Columbus over the Colorado river, went out again last night. A portion of this bridge was washed out in the big overflow during December, but was replaced by the citizens of Columbus and since that time the bridge has been in use again. The river at Columbus during the present high water, reached a height of 26 feet. It fell some five feet, and when another two foot rise came last night, that same portion of the east bridge that was washed out during the December overflow went out again last night. Since the new structure cannot be recently let contracts for rebuilding the three county bridges, it is not thought that this bridge will be temporarily repaired again but no work will be done until it is permanently rebuilt according to contract.

FOURTEEN ALLIGATORS KILLED ON LAKE MONDAY

Local Hunters Kill Fourteen Alligators on Lake Monday Night Some Big Ones.

In all they killed fourteen, but owing to the depth of the water about twelve feet, they were able to get only two into the boat. It is said that quiet a commotion was occasioned in the boat when one of the six-footers, which had been only stunned by the bullet, suddenly revived and came to life. The boys say that "Juke" was preparing to make a long swim to shore, stating that the boat that they were in was not large enough for him and a live alligator both, but the gator was promptly killed.
