the country over, but failed to find the negro man or woman. On Wednesday morning the Sheriff at Giddings telephoned Sheriff Mayes that he had arrested the negro at that place, and that the negro man had pistol wound in his left shoulder. Sheriff Mayes left this morning for Giddings and will bring the prisoner back to Columbus tonight. The Sheriff at Giddings stated that Turner says he lost the woman and did not know where she was. It is believed that the two, after making their escape from the house, caught a Sap train for Yoakum, where the man continued his flight on the Waco branch until he reached Giddings where he was arrested. The officers are still looking for the woman and no doubt it will be only a matter of a short time until she will be taken into custody. A charge of assault to murder will be sworn out against both the man and the woman.

Mr. J. W. Walker of Altair who was in the city yesterday morning, stated that the negro woman who took part in the shooting was not the wife of Turner, but his sister.
