TOMATO GROWERS HAVE ABOUT FINISHED SOWING SEEDS FOR SPRING CROP

A Few Who Signed For Acreage Did Not Plant; But Others Increased, Says Mr. Snodgrass, And Required Acreage Is Met.

Sowing of seeds in the hot beds for the coming crop of tomatoes has been the order of the week, and will be practically completed by the end of the week. Possibly a few of the growers will not finish their sowing until the first of the coming week. Mr. A. M. Snodgrass, county agent, stated.

The new venture crop, this being the first crop of tomatoes ever grown here for market, is going favorably. While Mr. Snodgrass states that one or two who had signed up to plant an acreage in tomatoes have not done so, other have increased their acreage, and on the whole the total acreage will be as had at first been planned.

Mr. Snodgrass, an experienced tomato grower, says that some of the fields here, especially some of the fields in the bottoms that will be planted in tomatoes look wonderful to him. He believes that the richness of the land, if the season is favorable and instructions are carried out, that the tomato yield is going to be excellent.

NINE MEXICANS HELD AFTER WILD PARTY ON CHRISTMAS EVE

One Man Seriously Shot; Another Thought He Was; Some Half Shot, When Officers Appear And Capture Still.

Nine Mexicans were taken into custody by Deputy Sheriff Joe Osoba and landed in the county jail at Columbus as the result of a wild party on the night of Christmas Eve.

Three of the men were later released, and charges varying from liquor law violations to carrying concealed weapons and assault were filed against the others.

In the general fight and disturbance at the party, Julian Osoba was shot in the stomach, the bullet coming out near the groin and entering and lodging in the leg. The Mexican told officers that he had been shot twice, but the officers are of the opinion that the wounds were made by the one bullet. He is thought to be seriously wounded.

Augustine Munier, living near Bonus, was severely beaten up in the fight. He reported to officers that he had been shot. At the Bonus Mexican home officers found a 25-gallon still and a hundred pounds of mash. The mash was buried in the ground with a chicken coop placed over it. Mr. Osoba said. At the same place the officers found one-half gallon of whiskey, 250 beer bottles, 50 whiskey bottles and a quantity of jugs of various sizes.

Returning from the scene, Mr. Osoba arrested Pedro Dias on the road. Dias was carrying a 45 Colt's pistol and a charge of carrying concealed weapons was filed against him.

BOY KILLED WHEN CAR IS OVERTURNED ON HIGHWAY EAST BERNARD THURSDAY
