Department for inspection.

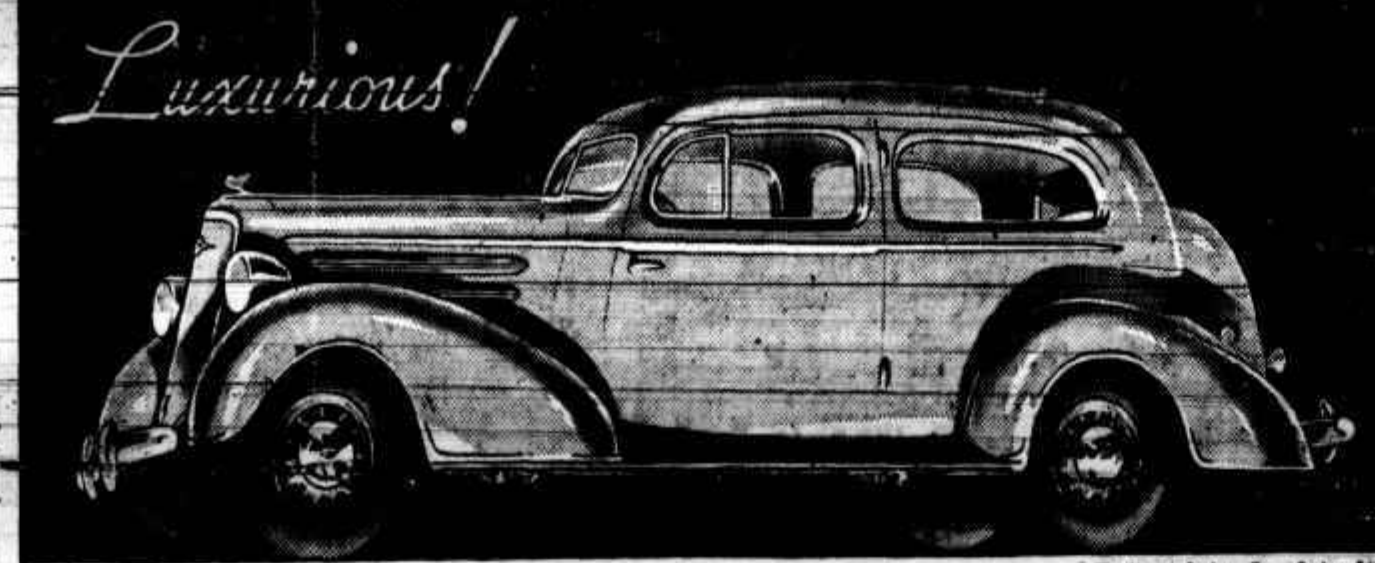
It is an interesting bit of work,

cause our payments to be delayed.

The Agricultural Council of Nade

dent, chairman, presiding. This

those present showed their interest
not only in farm questions, but
other matters that directly pertain
to their welfare. Alfred J. Kainer
outlined the program for the coming
year. The county agent talked on the
cotton situation and club work, then
two real speeches were presented by
R. J. Buchanan, teacher of voca-
tional agriculture at Garwood and
Mr. E. G. Marshall, supt. of Gar-
wood schools.

Other speakers were Prof. Men-
dler of the Nade school, E. B. Scul-
ling and farmers of the Nade com-
munity. If every citizen in the
county and the pep that Nade and
Garwood is showing, we would ac-
complish a great deal in an educa-
tional way during the coming year.
We hope that the other counties of
the county will follow their leader-
ship.

Ball created is considered one of

times. All the farm owners in the
Weimar section are requested to co-
operate with the Weimar Chamber
of Commerce and the county agent
in working out a program for the
