PRESERVING CUT FLOWERS
Mrs. Wm. Andel, Reporter: "Cut flowers will last four or five days longer if care is given the flowers. Sweet Williams and other flowers with woody stems should have the ends crushed with the back of a knife. Hairy stems like poppies and anemones may be burned with a match, sealed with hot water or scalded. These last three have a film of air that keeps the water from the stem. Hold the ends of a hollow stem under water and make a seal at the top by let air out and let water in. Aspirin dissolved in water revives wilted flowers. Some flowers cannot be put into the same containers with others. They will cause the others to wilt. Sweet peas cause any other flower to wilt, but other flowers immediately drop their heads."
