**CHANGES IN GAME LAWS  
FOR SOUTHERN DISTRICT**

Herewith is given some of the State and Federal game laws, which conflict in some respects, but it is expected that the present called session of the legislature will straighten out the differences:

The deer season is open from No-

November 20th to December 19th, during which time shooting is permitted from 7:00 a. m. to 4 p. m. No more early morning crawling up on ponds and pot shooting—that is no more legality.

The dove season is from December 1st to January 5th, from 7:00 a. m. to sundown, with a bag limit of fifteen.

The quail season is open from December 1st to January 16th, with

a bag limit of 12 birds a day.
