Yet how could he have said what he did say without saying it in the way he said it? Of course, he might have elaborated and made half a dozen lines out of a four-line item.

"Italy negotiated with Menelik the famous treaty of Uccialli which gave Italy a virtual protectorate over Ethiopia by providing that Ethiopian foreign relations should be handled through Italy. Menelik, however, disagreed.

"Meanwhile the Italians were pushing farther into Eritrea and Ethiopia in the same region in which they are now advancing. They took Agordat (now in Eritrea) in 1890.
