AN ORDINANCE

Prohibiting the placing or throwing

of any refuse, tin cans, scrap

iron, auto wrecks, rubbish or trash

of any kind on the premises of an-

other, without the consent of the

owner or owners of such premises

or the accumulation of rubbish or

scrap iron, auto wrecks, tin cans,

or refuse of any kind that may

become a nuisance or create a place

for vermin to breed, or where water

may accumulate wherein mosqui-

toes may breed and be unsightly

or permit the accumulation of any

of the aforesaid and enumerated

things or articles in such a man-

ner as to create a fire hazard or

be detrimental to the health of

those living in proximity to said

premises, or to cause the property

or premises of such person or per-

sons accumulating said things,

articles or rubbish to be unsightly

and to cause adjacent property to

depreciate in value, and declaring

such acts of accumulating such re-

use, things, articles or rubbish to

be a nuisance and providing for

the regulation of such business that

accumulates such things, articles

and products as scrap iron, and

auto wrecks, commonly known as

terms "junk yard" and "City Of-

fers," and for the regulation of

garages and blacksmith shops with-

in the City Limits of the City of

Eagle Lake, Colorado County, Tex-

as, and providing a penalty for the

violation of this ordinance and

declaring an emergency.

ENACTED BY THE CITY

COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE

LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That it shall be un-

lawful for any person or persons

to place, or cause to be placed,

any refuse, tin cans, scrap iron,

auto wrecks, rubbish or trash of

any kind on the premises of an-

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
