### FORMER BAPTIST PASTOR HERE IS BURIED TODAY

Funeral services for Rev. J. A. Stephen, 73, formerly pastor of the local Baptist church, were held at 2:30 this Friday, morning at Lexington.

Mr. Stephen died at his home, 820 Fairview, in Houston, Wednesday afternoon. For a number of years he was pastor of the Baptist church here and also held pastorates at Sealy, El Campo, Sonora, Hearne, and other Texas cities. He had resided in Houston for the past two years and at the time of his death was pastor of the church at Wallis and Dime Box. He was one of the strong forces in Baptist work in the coast section of Texas for thirty-five years. He was stricken Tuesday night while returning from filling an engagement at one of his churches. Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Elizabeth Stephen; two daughters, Mrs. Ann D. Morrison and Mrs. Grace T. Greig, both of Austin; three sons, John E. Stephen, of Houston, J. W. E. Stephen of Houston and Carroll Stephen of Sonora, and two brothers.

### PROMINENT NEW ULM MERCHANT PASSES AWAY

Funeral services were held at New Ulm at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon for Mr. J. J. Franks, 73, prominent citizen and merchant of New Ulm, who died in the St. Mary Hospital at Galveston Sunday night.
