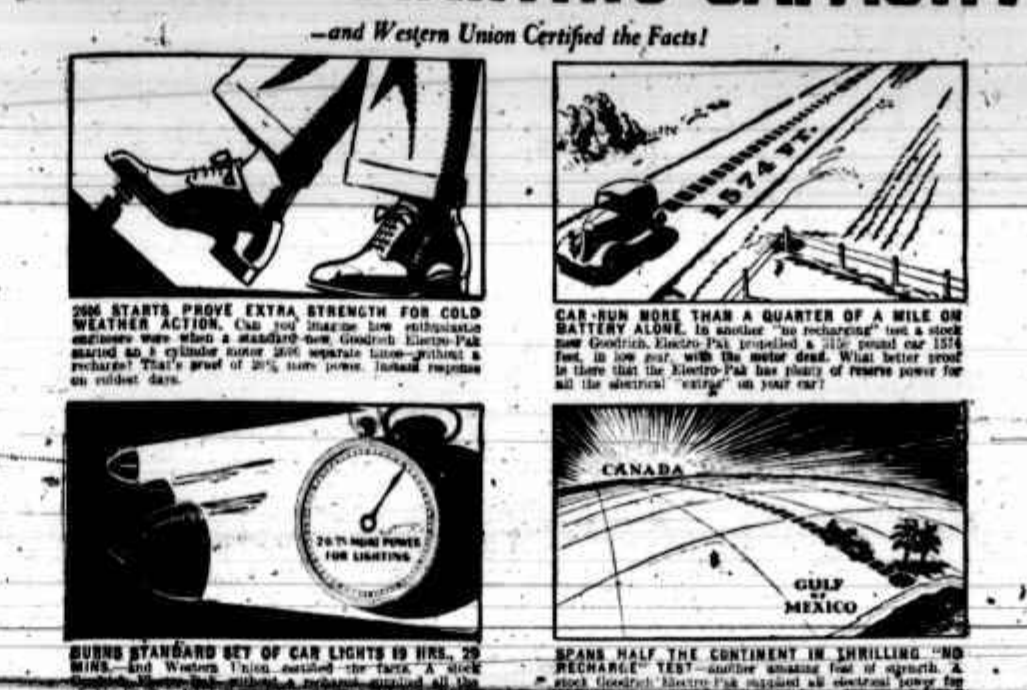
Mitchell Enshoff of Houston was here Sunday. In company with his father, Fritz Enshoff of this city, they spent the day visiting relatives in Houston.
