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Unusual Wildcat Drilling

Campaign in Wharton
And Matagorda Counties

The most concentrated drilling campaign in the Texas Gulf Coast is now being waged in Wharton and Matagorda counties where a total of 16 tests are being scheduled to be drilled within 30 days.

This activity is centered within a radius of about 30 miles, along a so-called "trend" that extends through the south half of Wharton county and the north half of Matagorda county.

The incentive for such a large exploration program followed discovery of a geophysical "high" extending from the town of Wharton, deep south along the east side of the Colorado River into Matagorda county, where a total of six geophysical prospects have been uncovered within an area of about 10 miles.

The discovery of such fields as Skelly (Bay City) and Hamman during the past year has been instrumental in the revival of activity in this county. Until their discovery there were only two producing fields in the county.

Three of the six proposed tests have been drilled and are scheduled to be drilled during the week. They are, on the north end of the high, the J. Smith and John McKenzie, S. A. Larche, Joseph Clements and Castellan surveys.
