Sen. Tower Applauds USDA Action On Rice

Senator John Tower, R-Texas, has applauded action by the Dept. of Agriculture in setting rice allotment quotas at last year's level. The Department announced last week that it was setting the 1971 crop allotment at 1,535,461 acres.

At a late November meeting in Washington with Agriculture Under Secretary Phil Campbell and a delegation of Texas rice growers, Tower had expressed his concern over the possibility that the government might set the minimum statutory rice allotment of 1,652,000 acres; last year's level.
