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Final Rites Held For Justin Smith

Many relatives and friends gathered at the chapel of the Mill-Bauer Funeral Home at 2:00 p.m. last Wednesday, Jan. 26, 1972 to pay final respects to Justin A. Smith, prominent contractor in this community for many years. Mr. Smith died at the Eagle Lake Hospital on Jan. 24 at 10:50 p.m. Monday, Jan. 24th of a heart attack. He had been confined to his home for a number of years with failing health.

The Rev. Sherrell Hall, pastor of the Little United Methodist Church, officiated at the services. Special organ music was provided by Mrs. Alice Schmidt and she accompanied the soloist, Ed Causey who sang, "In the Garden" as a special request of the family.

He was placed to final rest in the Lakeside Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were six nephews, Claude E. White, Jr., Russell White, Wm. T. Eggers, Jr., John M. Eggers, George Seahorn and Marvin Gorman. The family named as honorary pallbearers, Dr. J. R. Laughlin, Dr. J. C. Laughlin, David R. Wintermeyer, J. J. Renick, K. E. Bauer, John Beseda, Ed Causey, Hammie Raasch, and Everett Isenbarger.

Justin Almerin Smith was born Feb. 25, 1895 in Concordia, Kansas, the son of Harriet Ellen Campbell and George Baker Smith. The family lived in Kansas and later moved to the Lissie community in 1909. After his service with the U. S. Army in World War I, he returned to Lissie.

He served with the U. S. Tank Corps in France under Gen. Geo. S. Patton where he received injuries from gas and shrapnel about the head and wrist. He received the Purple Heart and won citations of Merit and Courage from his commanding officer.

Upon his return to the states, he received a medical discharge at Maryland and returned to his home at Lissie.

After his marriage to Miss Lois Waddell in Eagle Lake on March 15, 1921, he followed the building trade in Corpus Christi, Houston, and the defense plant work in Freeport during World War II. During this time, he made an intensive study of designing and building bridges and gained skills in construction.

Upon his return to Eagle Lake he entered the general contracting business and engaged in this profession until his retirement in 1961.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Lois Smith of this city; one sister, Mrs. Lucy Edwards of Houston; one brother, Chas. W. Smith of Houston; and numerous nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grand-nephews.

He was a member of the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. He always demonstrated a great interest in local state and national government and served always for the betterment of his community.

He spent the last years of his life peacefully with his family, loved ones and friends. He shall be missed dearly by all who came to know him.
