Mary Burris, indicted for assault with intent to murder Bobbie Marie Wilson Oct. 24, 1973.

A jury of Paul Keith Nichols was indicted for malice-mischief in damage to a wiring on a gravel truck owned by Ervin Gladney Dec. 14, 1973; by Robert Olivera on an indictment of burglary in the First Family Company Co. on Feb. 6, 1973; and by Eva Samora indicted for forgery and passing of several checks on the account of Munoz Equipment Co.

Bond forfeitures were entered by Judge Patterson against Ben Lionel Giles, Antonio Cantis Riles and Joe Ricardo Rides indicted for possession of marijuana in a amount over four ounces; Esther Martinez for indictment on two counts of possession with other checks given to Young Memorial Hospital; Wilfred G. Franks, Sr., indicted for defrauding with a worthless check given to the National Refining Co.

He counts foremost among his accomplishments projects like: the Gary Job Corps Center in San Marcos, rural water corporations, serving many counties, an Urban Mass Transit System, the Colorado River, a water quality and waste water management study of the Colorado River, a pollution cleanup program for the Highland Lakes in Central Texas, and a transportation research center at the University of Texas in Austin. These are only a few of his accomplishments.
