Nada CDA Plans For Dist. Meet Mar. 17

Catholic Daughters of America, Court Our Lady of the Rosary No. 1595, Nada, met for their regular meeting on February 12, 1974 at 7:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall. The members were called to order by the Regent Margaret Bunge. The State Regent Millie Schilling led in prayer, the pledge to the flag and the opening of the meeting. The first 1 1/4 hours of a 40-hour workshop go to pay Federal, state and local taxes. In other words, a local worker has to put in all day Monday and a good part of Tuesday to meet his tax bills. Most of that money, the portion that the Federal government withholds from paychecks for its two biggest taxes—personal income and Social Security—never reaches him. It is skimmed off before he gets his pay. The Government's yield from these two taxes more than 10 percent of the nation's gross national product. The fact that income in Colorado County and elsewhere went up sharply. The average family in the local area had a gross income, prior to tax withholding, of some \$66,000 in the past 10 years, the figures show. Out of this total, an estimated \$9,000 went for Federal income and Social Security taxes alone. But the public pays a lot more in Federal taxes than is taken out via withholding. The Tax Foundation notes. In fact, it says a whole raft of excise taxes, covering everything from cigarettes to processed butter and from gasoline to telephone service. The figures indicate that for every \$100 a worker pays in Federal income and Social Security taxes, the Government collects an additional \$74 in such "hidden" taxes. For the Colorado County population, the amount paid in the past 10 years in hidden taxes, on that basis, adds up to \$6,700 per family.

Two New Rice Varieties Released

Two new rice varieties have been released by the U. S. Department of Agriculture and the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station. According to Bollich, the variety Braxos has a high yield potential as well as excellent brewing qualities. It is early maturing, has superior lodging resistance and resistance to straight-tillable disease, and is a quality table rice.

The new varieties are Braxos, a medium-grain rice, and Lebonet, a long-grain type. Both were developed by Dr. Charles N. Bollich, agronomist with the USDA's Agricultural Research Service, Bollich conducts his work at the Texas A&M University-Agricultural Experiment Station, Beaumont, Texas.

The plant is generally four to eight inches shorter than other medium-grain varieties, an asset that accounts for some of Braxos' lodging resistance.

In three years of testing in Texas and in the Southeast, Braxos has out-yielded two common medium-grain rice, Nona and Vista, by 22 and 14 per cent respectively.

Lebonet is similar to Braxos in many respects, according to Bollich, the new variety could help meet the increasing demands for brewer's rice.
