# Raider Review

On Thursday, March 29, the  
Feast of the Passover begins and  
lasts for eight days. The  
feast, which scholars believe  
to be derived from an ancient  
spring time festival, came to be  
regarded by the Jews as a celebration  
of their birth from Egypt.  
It began over 3,000 years ago  
millennium before the Christian  
era and continues to the  
present day. It is one of the  
oldest festivals known to history.  
"Passover" which is  
widely accepted means Angel  
of Death.

During Passover they eat  
unleavened bread and observe  
the beginning of the feast they  
remove all leaven from their  
house and cleanse all their  
dishes to remove all possible  
traces of yeast. In order  
that there may be no yeast  
in the house, the head of the  
family on the eve of the feast  
puts a piece of leavened bread  
on a window sill and then lights  
a wax candle. Starting from  
the window they search  
unleavened bread and remove  
any trace of yeast which may be  
left, gathering it in a spoon  
until he returns to the starting  
place. Then he removes all  
the yeast from the house and  
lays it on a stone. The spoon  
is then placed over the stone  
and yeast is scattered over it.  
This is a great challenge,  
but the boys and girls  
have been known to  
successfully pass the challenge.

Both commented on the interior
