Crime Rate In State Up 3.1%

Colonel Wilson E. Speir, director of the Texas Department of Public Safety, announced that the Texas crime rate last year rose 3.1%.

Speir said 492,654 major criminal offenses were committed during 1973 for a rate per 100,000 population of 4,177.5. In 1972, there were 472,010 major offenses for a rate of 4,047.4.

In urban areas of Texas there were an estimated 440,997 major offenses as compared to 422,677 a year before. The urban crime rate rose by 4.9%, but in rural areas of the state, the crime rate was down 1.1% from the figure noted in 1972. Rural offenses totalled 43,557 contrasted to 49,334 the previous year.

The largest increase in crime was in the robbery in which 1,000 incidents of Murders and homicides were down by 2.1%. In other types of criminal activity, these rate increases were noted by the DPS: aggravated burglary, 1.5%; burglary, 2.8%; and theft, 2.9%; and auto theft, 2.4%.

Speir said that if the major crimes in Texas during 1973 had been evenly distributed as to frequency, there would have been one such offense every minute of every day.
