Reflexions on International Sunday School Lesson

(Colossians 1:15-17)

"All things were created by him."

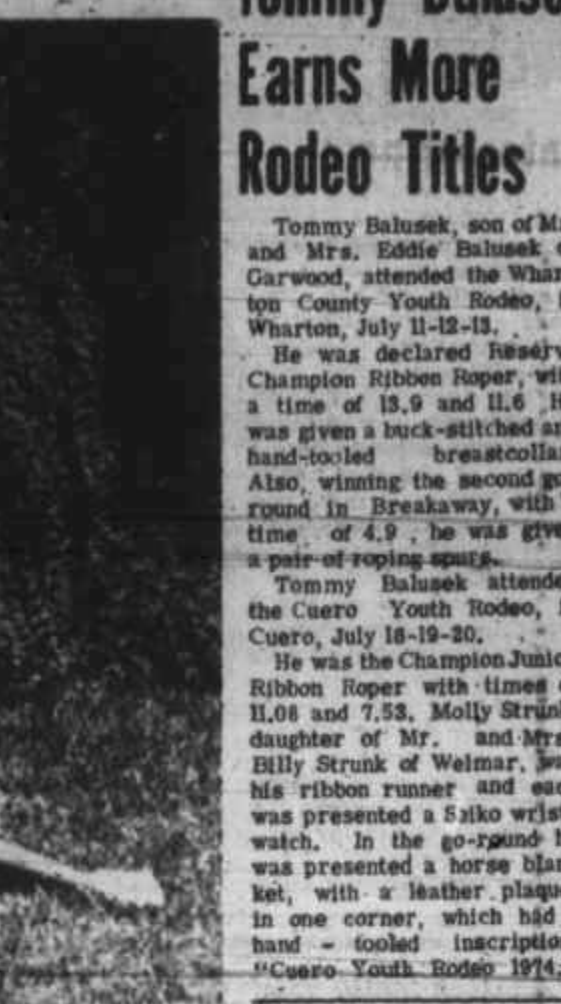
