## MARKET REPORT

WHARTON CO. LIVESTOCK - The market was weaker on all classes of cattle with the exception of slaughter calves and yearlings at the Wharton County Livestock Market, Inc., on July 31st. Most weakness was in light calves and the slaughter cows. Choice stocker and feeder steers in the 400 to 550 lb. range sold \$2 to \$4; 500 to 600 pound standard steers \$2 to \$3; 350 to 450 pound choice heifers \$1 to \$2; utility slaughter cows \$2 to \$2 1/2; utility slaughter bulls \$2 to \$3 with no top bulls offered. Choice stocker cows went from \$200 to \$225 per head. Feed lot calves in the 700 pound range sold \$2 to \$2 1/2. EAT MORE RICE!
