Wharton County Livestock Market Inc. reports that the market was stronger on most classes of cattle with most strength on slaughter cows and fat sucking calves at the sale August 7th.

Choice stocker and feeder steers in the 450 to 550 lb class sold \$3 to \$5; 500 to 600 pound standard steers were \$2 to \$3; 350 to 450 pound choice heifers brought \$1 to \$2; utility slaughter cows \$1 to \$2 1/2; utility slaughter cows brought \$100 to \$125 per head. Feed lot calves at 700 pounds sold \$3 to \$1 1/2 and fat slaughter calves, 400 to 500 pounds, went at \$2 to \$5.
