34 EXPECTED TO DIE IN LABOR DAY TRAFFIC

Colonel Wilson E. Speir, director of the Texas Department of Public Safety, estimates that traffic accidents in Texas over the Labor Day weekend will claim 34 lives. Speir noted that traffic deaths in Texas, which earlier were running up to 307, under the 1973 toll, have been rising throughout the summer months. He said the upward trend is related to heavier traffic and an alarming disregard for the 55 mile speed limit.

The DPS director said every effort would be made to prevent accidents and to bring about all available DPS troopers on duty during the holiday period, which extends from 6 p.m. Friday, August 30, through midnight Monday, September 2.

Speir noted that many local law enforcement agencies will be cooperating in the all out effort to make the streets and highways safer.

In addition, he said the DPS would be working with the news media in a special public education program called "Operation Motorcade." A concerted effort will be made to focus public attention on where and why traffic accidents are occurring during the holiday.
