Counties At Family Land Heritage Program

18 Family Farms in County Cited

Friedrich Double Hay Show Winner

More than 1,000 people representing some 280 families attended the first Family Land Heritage Program ceremony, initiated by Agriculture Commissioner John C. Walle, at the 1974 State Fair in Texas.

Families who have lived and worked their land for 100 years or more received certificates of recognition in the program sponsored by the Texas Department of Agriculture at the State Fair, October 14th.

Physical scores are based on maturity (40%), texture (30%), leafiness (10%), foreign matter (20%), and color (10%). The physical score was placed on samples by Al Novosad, Pasture Specialist for the Texas Agricultural Extension Service stationed at College Station.

Quality of hay on Colorado County farms is high. The annual hybrid tested in 1973, the 1973 samples, there were 49 Coastal samples which averaged 10.45% Crude Protein. This year, the 40 samples entered averaged 9.37% Crude Protein.

The show is not necessarily a true indication of county hay quality, but should show the general trend.

If average County hay is one percent lower in Crude Protein, more of the decrease can be attributed to higher fertilizer costs, resulting in less effect on protein content than fertilizer rate. The hay fed livestock in winter.

ter performs two functions. It should furnish protein and energy. Some energy with no protein is usually available in standing grass in late winter. Any protein shortage in the hay feed must be made up with cubes, a salt-meat mix, or a liquid supplement.

Production of hay with protein content high enough to meet the animals' need if hay is to be fed anywhere is more economical than turning to one of the supplements.
