EDITORIALLY
SPEAKINGFCC Act Prohibits Unauthorized
Publication Of Communications

The attention of the public is called to the Federal Communications Act of 1962, as amended in October of 1962, which prohibits unauthorized publication or discussion of communications made over wire or radio systems. The Act provides for protection of transmission of news, public service, radio systems, such as two-way radios, C. B. radios, and high and low frequency law enforcement agencies, as follows:

"Sec. 605. No person receiving or assisting in receiving, or causing to receive, or assisting in transmitting, any interstate or foreign communication by wire or radio shall divulge or publish the existence, contents, substance, purpose, effect, or meaning of any communication made over the wire or radio systems, or any part thereof, knowing that such information was so obtained, shall divulge or publish the existence, contents, substance, purpose, effect, or meaning of the same or part thereof, or the same or any information therein contained for his own benefit or for the benefit of another not entitled thereto: Provided, however, that the new arrival of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Jones is a baby daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Jones, is the former Pauline Marshall.
