The intercom, official publication for St. Luke's Episcopal and Texas Children's Hospitals in Houston, recently carried a lengthy article describing a new neurological surgery service which has been made available and the story had a picture of Dr. Warren Parker using an operating microscope to perform brain surgery. Dr. Parker is a native of Eagle Lake and is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Franklin F. Reese of this city. Dr. Parker is nearing the end of a six-year program of residency at the Texas Children's Hospital and has practiced with some of the outstanding surgeons in the United States.

The article described one of the newest clinical programs to offer services to patients in St. Luke's and Texas Children's Hospital, in the field of Neurological Surgery. Dr. Parker is affiliated with the Baylor College of Medicine. Chief of the Neurological Surgery Service is William R. Cheek, M.D. and assistant chief of Neurological Surgery Service is Richard H.
