Midshipman John S. Moore, son of Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Moore, of Eagle Lake, has been named to both the Deans' List and the Superintendent's List at the U. S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, Md., for the fall semester, academic year 1974-75.  
 He was cited for outstanding scholastic achievement and leadership during the semester.  
 The Texas Highway Department is planning the construction of FM Highway 3013, from the junction of US Highway 80A and FM Highway 102 to the junction of FM Highway 102 in Wharton County.  
 The proposed construction will be along an existing county road, known as the Eagle Lake-Cien Flora Road with some modifications at curve locations, and will consist of 12-foot surfaced traffic lanes and two 3-foot surfaced shoulders on a "minimum" right-of-way width of 120 feet. The proposed right-of-way width on the existing road is 45 feet minimum and 100 feet maximum.  
 Maps and other drawings showing the proposed location and geometric design, environmental studies and other information about the proposed project are on file and available for inspection and copying at the Resident Engineer's Office on US Highway 50, 2 miles west of Columbus, Texas 75934. Also, the drawings showing the proposed location and geometric design have been placed on file in the offices of the Wharton County Judge, Colorado County Judge and the Houston County Judge.  
 Information about the State's Relocation Assistance Program, the benefits and services for displacees and the relocation assistance office as well as information about the tentative schedules for the proposed project are on file at the Resident Engineer's Office.  
 An interested citizen may request that a public hearing be held covering the social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this highway project by delivering a written request to the Resident Engineer's Office on or before May 1975.  
 In the event such a request is received a public hearing will be scheduled and adequate notice will be published about the date and location of the hearing.

## Yield To Emergency Vehicles
