Bell Symbol Of Mental Health Fund Campaign



"This bell should ring out hope for the mentally ill and victory over mental illness."

These words are inscribed on the Mental Health Bell, the symbol of the Mental Health Association.

During May, a neighbor will be ringing the bell to ask for donations to support mental health. Mrs. Betty Fink, chairwoman of Eagle Lake will lead the campaign in Eagle Lake.

The bell symbol represents an actual bell, which was cast in 1963 from chains and handcuffs. Other metal restraints formerly used to bind mental patients, within the symbol, there is
