Nine Compete For FB Queen Honors





\$3.4 Million Budget Adopted For WCJC

The Board of Trustees at Wharton County Junior College in Wharton has adopted a 1975-76 fiscal year budget of \$3,451,443 with no tax increase despite an approximately 14 percent increase in expenditures. More than half of the budget will be financed by state funds which the legislature increased by 12 1/2 percent from \$1,549,082 to \$1,744,083.
