New S. Hamel Field Opened

A new field discovery in Colorado and Lavaca counties highlights oil and gas activity in this area.

Petro-Lewis Corp. is requesting a new field designation of "South Hamel" field with the completion of its No. 1 Kelleflet, a Wilcox discovery 12 miles southwest of Columbus in Colorado County.

The operator reported a daily flow on potential of 150 barrels of 34 gravity oil, 123,000 cubic feet of gas and 195 barrels of water through Wilcox perforations at 974-8720 feet. The well was tested on a 14/64 inch choke with a flowing tubing pressure of 950 pounds per square inch.

The discovery, bottomed at 10,500 feet, is on a 90-acre lease in J. P. Smith Survey A-503 three-quarters of a mile east of Yegon oil production from about 5,600 feet in Hamel field.

In Lavaca County, three miles north of Hallettsville, a well is producing 150 barrels of 34 gravity oil, 123,000 cubic feet of gas and 195 barrels of water through Wilcox perforations at 974-8720 feet. The well was tested on a 14/64 inch choke with a tubing pressure of 950 pounds per square inch.
