# CONG. PICKLE RELEASES BOOK ON POSTMASTERS, POST OFFICES

During the floods of 1913, Travis Brooks, the first rural carrier for the Columbus Post Office, had to use a skiff to deliver the mail on rural routes. Pickle presented the first copies of his personal contribution to the nation's Bicentennial. "The Postmasters and Post Offices of the United States Postal Service."

"There is something of interest in this book for every person in Central Texas and I think it will draw nationwide interest because it is the first published collection of its kind," Pickle said.

"The purpose of this bi-centennial project was to gather and record one area of Central Texas history and to preserve some of the rich and colorful ancestry of this part of the country," he said.

Pickle said he called the press conference to give recognition and appreciation to the members of the Postal History Advisory Committee, Forrest Brooks, Columbus postmaster, and Jack Montgomery, Waimar postmaster, both served on the Advisory Committee and represented Colorado County in the project.

"It took a lot of work by many people to see this project through," Pickle said. "And I want personally thank Forrest Brooks and Jack Montgomery for the fine jobs they did in helping us put this book together."

Pickle also discussed the role of the post office in the development of small communities. "The rural post offices were gathering spots for all citizens who came from far and near to pick up their mail and to see the postmaster."

"Many Texas towns were built by the railroads but it was the post office which with little funds earned no interest of any state in the postal system."

The Austin Congressman, who has joined a new battle against the U.S. Postal Service to prevent arbitrary closing of small post offices, said that "these small post offices are one of the strongest links in the postal system."

"Postmasters in small rural areas provide the best personal service because they know they are working for their friends and neighbors," Pickle said.

Pickle said he hoped the publication of the postal history book at this time would "point out the important function of the small post offices in rural areas."
