Water & Sewer Rate Ordinance
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND PROVIDING RATES FOR SERVICE OF THE WATERWORKS AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF; ESTABLISHING AND PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR CONNECTION TO SAID SYSTEM; REPEALING PROCEEDINGS IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, owns and operates a waterworks and sanitary sewer system; and WHEREAS, the City Council of said City wishes to amend and provide for monthly rates and charges for services of said system; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That effective the month of June, 1976, the following rates shall be charged each month for the service of the waterworks and sanitary sewer system of said City:

First 3,000 gallons, minimum	\$2.50
Next 7,000 gallons, per M gallons	.60
Next 10,000 gallons, per M gallons	.55
Next 10,000 gallons, per M gallons	.50
Next 10,000 gallons, per M gallons	.45
All over 40,000 gallons, per M gallons	.40

SEWER

Residences	\$2.00
Multi-family establishments per family unit	2.00
Mobile parks, per unit	2.00
Drug stores, large offices, department stores, furniture stores	4.00
Small offices	2.00
Grocery stores, markets	5.00
Service stations, garages, cafes, restaurants	6.00
Hotels, tourist courts, rooming houses, boarding houses	10.00

(for up to 10 openings plus 50¢ for each additional opening over 10)

All other services shall be as follows:

For 3/4" service	\$ 75.00
For 1" service	135.00
For 1 1/4" service	190.00
For 1 1/2" service	250.00
For 2" service	400.00

For service of other sizes to be agreed upon by the City Council and the person, firm, or corporation desiring service.

SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

For 4" service	\$30.00
For 6" service	50.00

For service of other sizes to be agreed upon by the City Council and the person, firm, or corporation desiring service.

Section 4. That beginning with this date, all ordinances and resolutions in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.
