Teen Raiders Win Zone Title

The Eagle Lake Teen Raiders, composed of players from the Rice District, nailed down the championship of the North Zone of the Tri-County Babe Ruth League Tuesday night with an impressive 10-3 victory over the Moulton Tens at the local City Ball Park.

Coach Butch Watson's Raiders finished the season with an 8-7 record, a game ahead of the Astros, who were the winners of the pack, completing an outstanding season of play.

ALL-STAR NAMED

Four of the Raiders were named to the North Zone All-Star team which will play the South Zone All-Stars to determine which will represent the league in further play leading to the national title.
