FARM WEATHER OUTLOOK THROUGH SATURDAY: Mostly cloudy skies, mild temperatures and scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms are forecast for the Texas Rice Belt through Saturday. Some isolated areas may receive as much as an inch of rainfall Tuesday afternoon or Wednesday. High temperatures this week will be mostly in the 80's with lows mostly in the 70's.
PAST WEATHER: Scattered showers and thunderstorms across the Rice Belt during the past 24 hours produced generally light rainfall. A few isolated areas did receive heavy rainfall, however. Wharton, for example, received 2 1/4 inches and heavier rains may have fallen in that area. High temperatures Monday were in the 80's over most of the Rice Belt except low 80's in the extreme northeast. Low temperatures Tuesday morning were in the 70's and low 80's.
RICE HARVEST: A few rain-caused delays are likely in early rice harvest into the weekend. Moderate to heavy dew will delay starting times until late mornings this week with a chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms during the afternoon.
WATERMELON HARVEST: Most fields should have dried, following the rains of last week. Scattered showers and thunderstorms may hamper early melon harvest in Waller County through the weekend.
PEANUT LEAF SPOT: Temperature and humidity were extremely favorable and are expected to remain very favorable for the remainder of the week for the development of peanut leaf spot infection.
APPLICATION OF AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS: East to southeasterly winds with speeds generally under 10 MPH will favor the application of most agricultural chemicals through Wednesday. The chance of showers, however, should be considered before deciding to apply chemicals.
